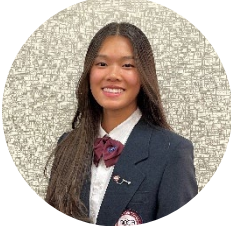

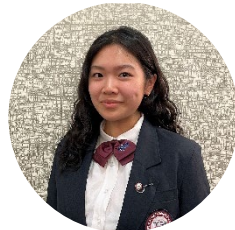

Keynote Speaker



Dr. Catherine "Leiana" Oswald obtained her Bachelor of Science in Nutritional Sciences from the University of Nevada Las Vegas (2004), and her Pharmacy Doctorate from Roseman University of Health Sciences (2007). She is an associate professor of pharmacy practice and a board-certified geriatric pharmacist.

Dr. Oswald serves as Roseman's College of Pharmacy Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and Assessment. She enjoys teaching in Roseman's Six-Point Mastery Learning Model covering topics that include Clinical Nutrition, Immunizations, Leadership, Pharmacy Law, Pharmacy and Medicare, and Pharmacy Capstone.

This past fall Dr. Oswald broke 1 million in grant funding for community work focused on advancing pharmacists' roles in caring for chronic medical conditions including diabetes and heart disease and helping future pharmacists understand the complexity of Medicare. She oversees Roseman Medicare Call Center which has helped save southern Nevadans over 2 million in estimated annual healthcare costs.

A former Division I NCAA student-athlete, Dr. Oswald spends time outside of work coaching her daughters' youth volleyball teams, cheering all four of her children on at various athletic events, and traveling to see family and friends across the country and in Canada whenever possible.

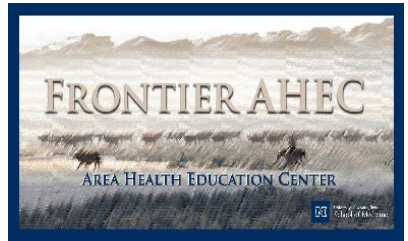

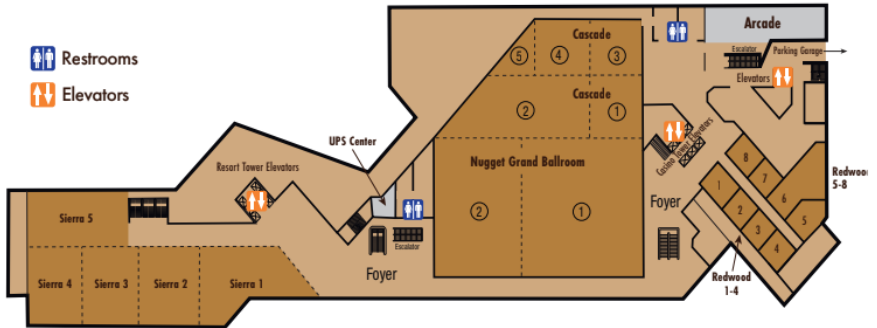

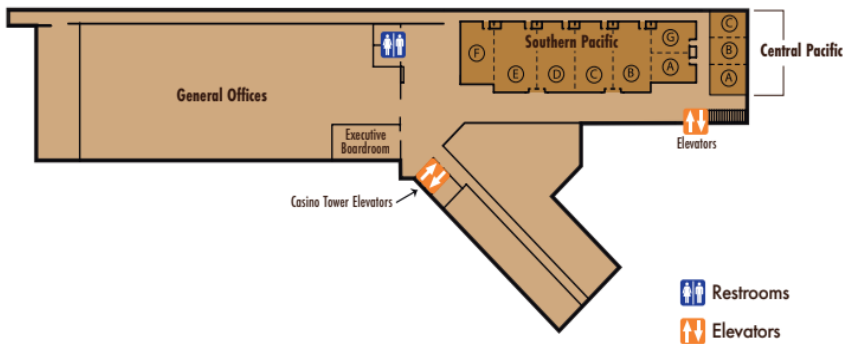


The Nugget Maps

2nd Floor

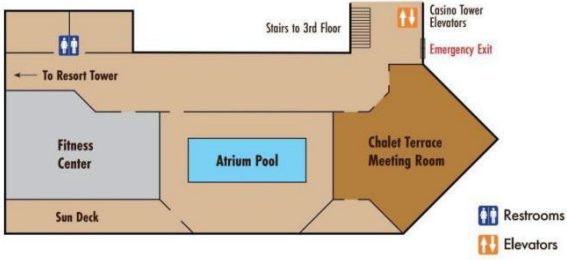

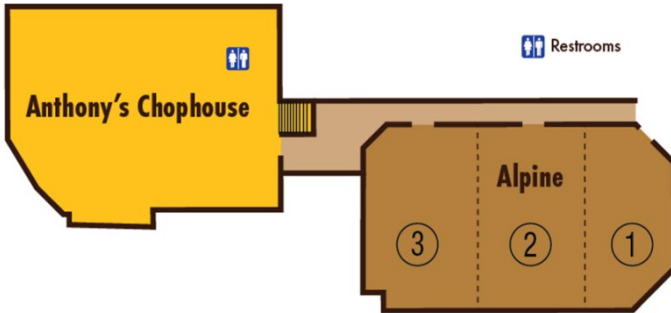
