Guatemala Point System

To have an efficient donation system and instill healthy competition between local chapters, the State Officer Team has put together a point system, specific to the Guatemala Service Project! Each item available to be donated has a quantity associated with it, which determines the amount of points the item is worth. All donation items are listed below with their associated quantity and point value. The top 3 chapters that achieve the highest point to membership ratio will receive recognition at the State Leadership Conference. **Items donated that are not listed below may receive additional points, up to discretion of the State Officer Team.

*All fluid items must be travel sized (100mls or less)

DENTAL

- Toothbrush (x2) = 1 point
- \circ Toothpaste (x1) = 1 point
- String Floss (x2) = 1 point
- O Mouthwash (x1) = 1 points
- Fluoride (x1) = 1 points

PHARMACY

- \circ Saline (x1) = 1 point
- Tylenol- individual packets (x1) = 2 points
- Advil- individual packets (x1)= 2 points
- Aspirin- individual packets (x1) = 2 points
- \circ Cough Drops (x1) = 2 points
- \circ Vitamins (x1) = 2 points
- Herbal teas- chamomile, mint, peppermint, green tea, lemon ginger, lemongrass and cinnamon (x1) = 2 points

WATER SANITATION

- LIFE filters (x1) = 10 points
- Water bottles (x1) = 5 points
- Hand Soap (x2)= 1 point
- Chlorine tablets (x1)= 5 point

MENTAL HEALTH

- \circ Books (x1) = 2 points
- \circ Oils (x1) = 1 point
- \circ Headphones (x1) = 10 points
- \circ Candles (x1) = 2 points
- \circ Coloring books (x1) = 2 points
- Journal (x1)= 1 point
- Coloring Pencils (x1) = 2 points
- Arts & Crafts (x1) = up to 5 points
- Sports Equipment (x1) = up to 5 points
- Games/Puzzles (x1) = up to 5 points
